Resolution 5 (2014)

Adopted by the Security Council at its Emergency Session, on 15 November 2014

The Security Council,

Calls for creating a special commission accountable to International Health Organization for monitoring the situation in the diseased countries and for examination of vaccine developed by CPR;

Proposes to set special border regime (for all countries), to set quarantine on the borders;

Urges to isolate infected people who already caught this disease by placing them into special temporary medical centers in order to prevent spread of this infection and to create an opportunity to investigate its causes;

Proposes all states to provide preferences to all their pharmaceutical companies attempting to find this virus vaccine and invites international community to support the research financially by the government, NGOs or private donations;

Urges all countries to create a special unit for investigating the cases of bioterrorism connected with this disease;

Propose Russia, CPR and Sweden to apply to the ICJ and urges these countries to present the proof in order to call a meeting of the SC to discuss it as a point of the agenda.
