Resolution 2

**adopted by the First General Assembly Committee
on 10 November 2017**

The General Assembly

Reaffirming the importance of national sovereignty and territorial integrity of each state as stated in the United Nations Charter,

Keeping in mind that some countries may regard foreign military bases as a violation of national sovereignty,

Deeply concerned that foreign military bases encourages militarism, arms race and aggressive actions,

Acknowledging that military bases contribute to achieving international stability, peace and protecting civilian populations,

1. *Calls upon* limiting the amount and types of weapons allowed in foreign military bases;
2. *Calls for* abolishing the immunity of soldiers outside the Foreign Military Bases so as that they will abide by the host countries' law;
3. *Strongly urges* all the sending nations to be responsible for any environmental damage caused in process of installation or operation of a base;
4. *Requests* forbidding the use and storage of radioactive substances in foreign military bases;
5. *Condemns* imprisonment and torture being held in foreign military bases
6. *Suggests* that the distribution of military facilities should correspond with the needs of a host country and situation in a region;
7. *Proposes* to create a set of rules and stands that will serve as a guarantee for protecting economic interests of host states;
8. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
