Resolution adopted by the Executive Committee of the United Nations High Commissioner on Refugees on 5 April 2018

Executive Committee of the United Nations High Commissioner on Refugees,

Having examined all the key problems of the agenda,

Being fully alarmed by the fact that the Lake Chad region is a conflict zone,

Bearing in mind the humanitarian crisis,

Following the principles and customs of international law,

Welcoming further cooperation from the member states of the UN, accept the following resolution.

1. Calls for engaging more countries in giving more military human support in order to protect the region by eliminating the Boko Haram terrorist group presence.

- 2. Urges to strengthen borders and increase the process of monitoring them.
- 3. Strongly recommends increasing the level of social help and human resources by:
 - a. spreading the information among the countries to attract more volunteers;
 - b. maintaining the Lake Chad region with all the necessary infrastructure for proper living (i.e. factories, buildings, etc.);
 - c. increasing the level of monitoring the situation to make the other countries aware of how vital the problem is.

4. Suggests the creation of an agricultural territory around the camp (if possible) in order to be less dependent on humanitarian aid.
