### Resolution 6 (2019)

**Adopted by the Security Council at its 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting  
on 15 November 2019**

*The Security Council,*

*Taking note into serious concern* at the deterioration of relations between the Republic of Armenia and the Azerbaijani Republic and at the tensions between them,

*Accepting* that the territory is recognized by the international community as the territory of the Azerbaijani Republic,

*Being aware of* continuing of endangering peace and security in the region,

*Expressing great concern* at the deterioration of relations between the Republic of Armenia and the Republic of Azerbaijan,

*Expecting* the peaceful resolution of the conflict,

*Emphasizing* the principles of respect for the territorial integrity and inviolability of internationally recognized state borders,

*Welcoming* effective contribution of the Member States and international and regional organizations and mechanisms within their competence, to the process of conflict resolution,

1. *Calls for* the OSCE to strengthen activities aimed at improving compliance with the ceasefire and enhance security in the Nagorno-Karabakh region, namely by:

i) developing a system of close interaction with the UN observer group,

ii) establishing an active and forehanded exchange of relevant information with the competent UN agencies, interstate regional organizations and parties involved in the conflict,

iii) proceeding its work on the basis of trilateral format in the framework of the Minsk Agreements on optimizing its operations, taking into account the peculiarities of the current situation;

2. *Calls* concerned parties *for* abstaining from any actions that discourage a peaceful solution to the issue and holding negotiations among the leaders representing Armenian, Azerbaijan and Nagorno Karabakh's interests by holding them in context of Minsk Group's work on a neutral venue;

3. *Calls for* active cooperation of the authorities of Armenia and Azerbaijan in the issues of:

i) searching for people missing as a result of the conflict,

ii) facilitating the reunification of families separated by the conflict on the territory of their current residence in Nagorno-Karabakh region or beyond;

4. *Proposes* organizing a United Nations Special Peacekeeping Mission in the Nagorno-Karabakh region which main objectives will be:

i) organization of a ceasefire monitoring system by UN observers,

ii) provision of food, clothing, medicine and other humanitarian assistance to the affected civilian population of the conflict parties,

iii) establishing a system for monitoring fundamental human rights;

8) *Urges* both sides to resume the negotiation for the resolution of the conflict within the framework of the peace process of the Minsk group and refrain from any action that will destroy a peaceful solution of the problem by the following measures:

i) choosing the country-mediator that will observe the situation in the region,

ii) starting prisoner of war procedure under the supervision of international qualified bodies such as but not limited to the UN and OSCE in accordance with the Geneva Convention of August 12, 1949.
