Resolution 2 (2015)

Eradication of Hunger

Adopted by the Economic and Social Council at its 3rd meeting, on 12 November 2015

Economic and Social Council,

Affirming the obligation of all the States in front of future generations to achieve Sustainable Development Goals,

Convinced that eradication of hunger as the Second SDG can be fulfilled only through tight cooperation of all Member-States,

Emphasizing the urgent character of this problem and need to be solved in the closest time,

Pointing out the great concern to results of solutions to eradication of hunger in this regard,

1. *Suggests* providing regular financial aid to the developing countries with hunger problem fully controlled by specified UN committees;
2. *Proposes* to broaden a list of basic products providing sufficient vitamins and minerals nutrition, with stable price for developing countries;
3. *Requests* improving agricultural productivity with providing modern equipment;
4. *Suggests* stimulating farming industry and providing benefits for the farmers by the Government of a certain country;

5. *Calls upon* supporting and training small farmers from poor African and Asian countries underdeveloped and developing countries;

6. *Asks* to share experience in overcoming hunger in political and economic way by exchange of highly-qualified specialists from countries that have already coped with this problem to those countries which still experience such problem;

7. *Suggests* to improve further developing of existing Charity Foundations aiming to help developing countries in solving problem of hunger.
